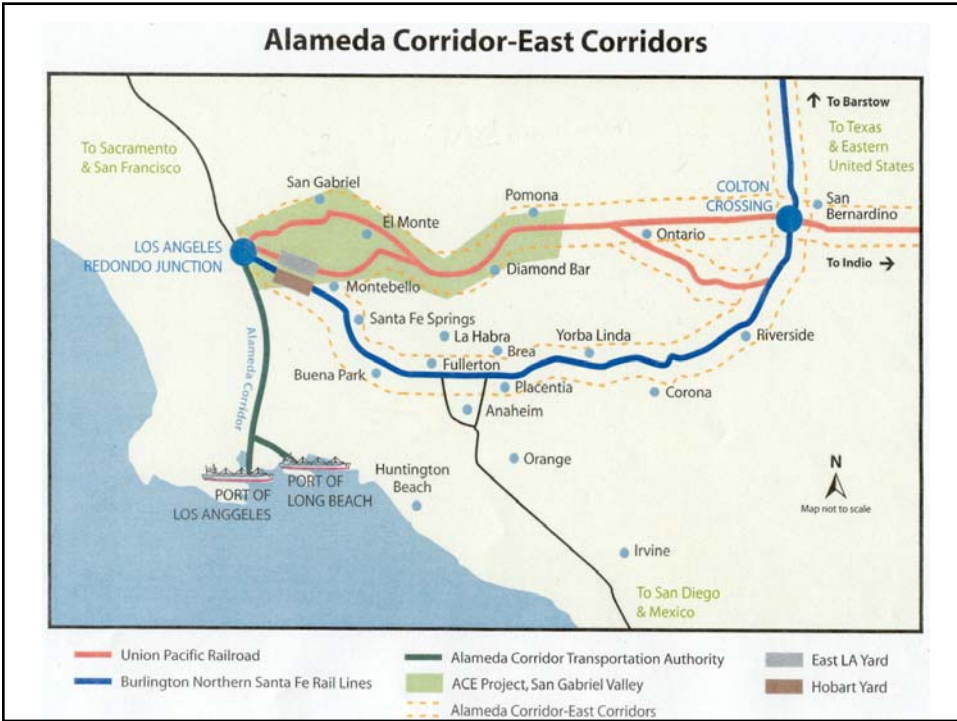


ALAMEDA CORRIDOR-EAST PROJECT



SAN GABRIEL VALLEY ACE PROJECT

- Ten grade separations, safety improvements at 39 crossings, pilot signal synchronization program
- 75 route miles
- Serves area of 2 million residents
- \$950 million project
- First half funded (\$530 million)

- East End Ave Grade Separation – Pomona
- Reservoir St. Grade Separation – Pomona
- Temple Ave. Train Diversion – Pomona

SAN GABRIEL VALLEY BENEFITS

- 10 – 24 minute wait times eliminated at 20 crossings
- Train noise eliminated at 20 grade separations
- 221 tons of air pollutants eliminated annually
- 192,000 jobs preserved
- Grade crossing accidents eliminated

ACE PROJECT FINANCING

- No Revenue Financing Opportunities to Date
- Phase I Grant Funded
 - Federal (40%)
 - State (40%)
 - Local/Railroad (20%)
- Phase II Funding (\$500M+)
- Governor's Goods Movement Action Plan
- Pending State Legislation
